Our group of friends, the GED Brunch Leadership Committee, is excited to welcome you to our 18th Annual Fabulous GED Brunch! Thanks to all of you, it will be another wonderful event filled with great friends coming together to support education in our community. Your involvement will help those in our city seeking a GED to better support themselves and their families. In 2019, the City of San Antonio reported that 18% of local residents do not have a high school equivalency. This is almost double the national rate of 9.9%. We have much work to do! Those without a GED are at risk of living in poverty.

Thankfully, GED classes through community programs at the Alamo Colleges serve over 700 GED students each year. Since 2008 this group has made it our priority to help those students.
